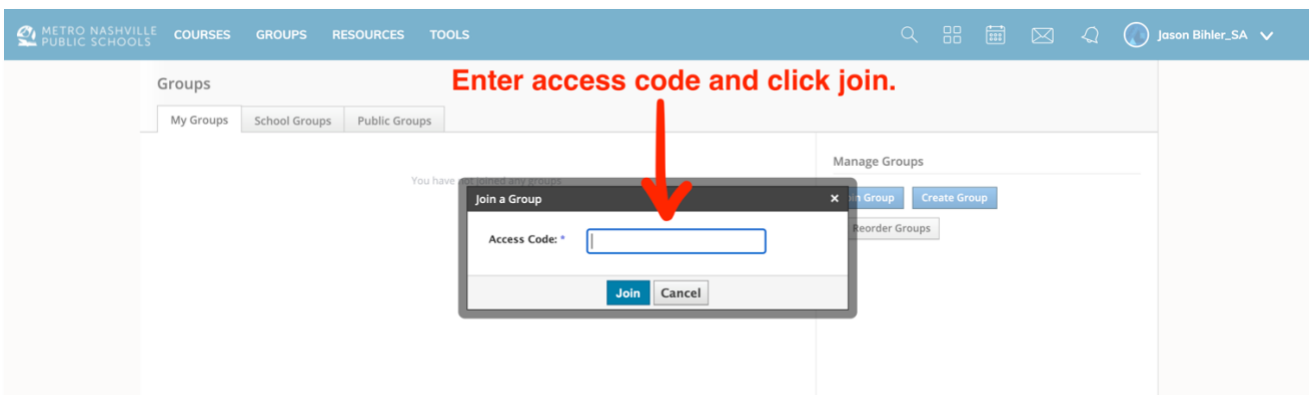
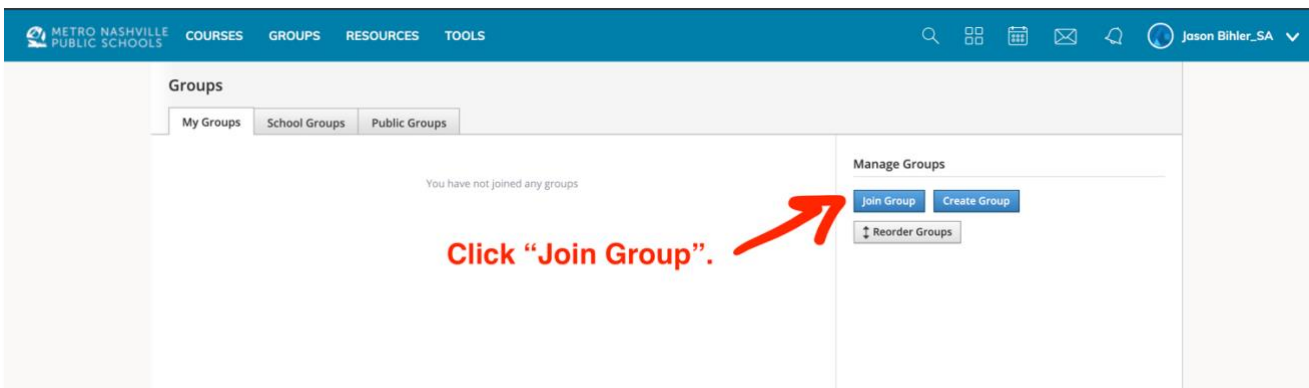


## Quick Guide:

### How to access your FLVS content and copy it to your Schoology courses

1. Login to Schoology
  - a. <http://mnps.schoology.com> (username@mnps.org and normal password).
2. Join the “MNPS District Provided Content” Group.
  - a. Click on “Groups” located in the blue navigation bar
  - b. Click on “My Groups” located in the upper right corner
  - c. Click “Join Group”
  - d. Enter the following access code: 9GZX-QJVV-54N7X and click “Join”. DO NOT ADD extra spaces.



3. After successfully joining, click on “Groups” located in the blue navigation bar
4. Click on “MNPS District Provided Content” Group (it will be available in your groups after joining).
5. Click on “Resources” in left hand navigation window
6. Locate the content you would like to copy to your course.

**Economics**
